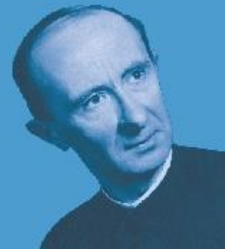

Dear Friends,

The cause is moving forward. The *Positio* - or text presenting Father Caffarel's life and work - is in the hands of the Theologian Consultors. Then it will be the Cardinals' turn. The Pope will then be able to sign a decree declaring Father Caffarel "Venerable." His beatification will then be possible. But on one condition: that God himself ratifies the opinion of the Church by performing a miracle through the intercession of Father Caffarel. When will the miracle and beatification come about? Our confidence gives us hope, because God's affairs go at their own place!

For now, we still have a lot of work to do.

All of us must accompany this entire process. We need to make Father Caffarel and his message better known, since the goal of all beatification is that Christians – and society at large – can grow in this path of love.

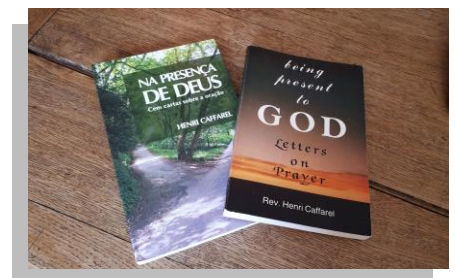
***In real terms, this means that Father Caffarel's written work needs to be better known.***

To put it another way, experience shows that publishing houses play an essential role in supporting a beatification.

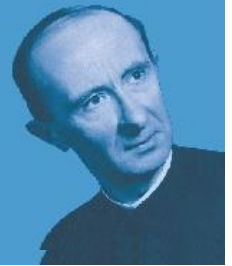
Good luck! And let's not forget to say the prayer asking for Father Caffarel's canonization!

For many years now, particular texts or books of Father Henri Caffarel's have been translated into different languages, mainly into the 5 official languages of the Teams of Our Lady movement, but also into other languages. However not all the texts are currently known nor are they necessarily made available to all those who would like to be able to use them. It is also true that texts that have already been translated by one translator have been translated again by another translator.

With the help of correspondents and Responsible Couples of each SR and attached Region, it therefore appears urgent and necessary to carry out a complete inventory of all these translations in order to centralize them. Once done, these texts will be digitalized and posted on the Friends of Father Caffarel's association's website and the list will be updated regularly.

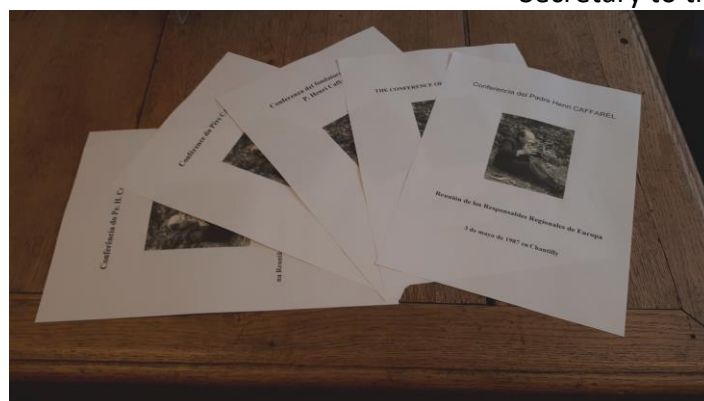
