
O Merciful Mother, give us the courage to reject the culture of death and the strength to build a new Culture of Life

As the International Leading Couple for the Teams of Our Lady, you announced at the most recent International College at Swanwick that the 12th International Gathering of Team members would be held in Fatima, Portugal, from July 16th to 21st, 2018.

Can you give us the reasons for choosing this place?

Fatima was chosen by the Regional Responsible Couples who took part in the International Regional Responsible Couples' Gathering in Rome in 2015. The International Leading Team consulted all the responsible couples present and the Sanctuary of Fatima was chosen with a majority of over 60%.

What role do the International Gatherings play in the life of the Movement?

They are important moments when the international aspect of the Movement can be experienced as a whole and when the new orientations of the Movement as defined by the ERI (International Leading Team) every six years can be announced.

These orientations are proposals that aim to help the Teams of Our Lady to truly journey together in unity.

Father Henri Caffarel associated big gatherings with pilgrimages. What do you think of that?

We completely agree with his vision.

To be able to participate in a big Gathering is an opportunity that enables us to nurture and develop the deepest sense of what a pilgrimage is, primarily for couples and then afterwards within the Movement, because it is terribly important to take care of the person who walks at our side.

Will this next Gathering have a theme and if so, what is it? Can you give us some key words that summarize it?

There will, of course, be a theme. The ERI (International Leading Team) always uses the Gospel as its starting point and from there tries to respond to the current concerns of the Church and the world.

Pope Francis reminded us that Teams couples are called, more than ever, to the mission; but according to our particular charisma and our vocation of love.

Therefore, our great concern will be to figure out the role of a true Mission of Love, full of mercy and joy, just like the one we are in particular need of today.

The Benz' also invited two other couples from their team: Ed and Anne Franco and Peter and Cindy Warner to come to the dinner. We spent the evening talking Teams "stuff" and they were all SO delighted to hear that the position of Liaison Couple was coming back to the US Super Region. That evening it was like being in a little bit of heaven, being around these three couples, who took the "responsibility" of Teams (hospitality to fellow Teams members), to a new level. We witnessed a commitment to the movement that we pray for all Teams couples. These couples had been on Teams for 50 years, over half of their lives!

The challenge for couples will be to turn the contribution attitude into:

- a) faith response and an opening to the Word of God which will bring us out of ourselves to place us completely in the hands of God.
- b) an opportunity to cooperate in the welcome of so many couples who through Teams of Our Lady try to find a path to holiness in their married life.

On a personal level, we have had the opportunity to pilot and oversee the piloting of new teams and the enthusiasm and the commitment is a witness to the need to support and spread the "good news of Teams of Our Lady".

Teams of Our Lady has no source of income other than the financial support of its members. When Teams of Our Lady came into existence, it was decided to ask each couple in Teams throughout the world to contribute annually the equivalent of one days wages thus being equitable to all couples no matter their economic status.

Your continued support will help USA Super Region to grow and continue the "Mission" of Teams of Our Lady. We are asking that all Teams couples contribute. This way all shoulder the continued life of the movement since we all receive of its Life and Gifts.

You can still contribute by "check" or "bill pay". (With bill pay you can spread your contribution throughout the year and when the contribution envelope is given to the Responsible Couple you simply place a note in the envelope that you are giving by "bill pay".) 
