This theme immediately brings to mind the scripture verse from Matthew 13:33 "The kingdom of heaven is like yeast that a woman took and mixed with three measures of wheat flour until the whole batch was leavened." Yeast is an almost microscopic organism that's impact can be seen once allowed to work in a batch of dough. With a little warmth, the dough can expand beyond the bowl where it resides. 

Dear Team Friends,

We'd like to say THANK YOU for your financial support! Without it we could not continue our mission of supporting Christian marriage in the USA Super Region. **Because of your support we have the ability to grow our movement!**

We give thanks for the founding four couples whose hearts burned to increase their married love not only

Please contact info@teamsofourlady.org for more information. For our Team members who are over 70.5-year-old, the IRS allows you to make gifts from your IRA without being taxed on the withdrawal. Is Christian Marriage Leaven in the world?

It is certainly counter-cultural. Marriage trends in the US continue downward. Forty years ago there were 10 weddings per 1000 people; in 2000 the rate was about 8; in 2018, the last year for which we have the number, there were just over 6. The number of young adults of marriage age who are married is the biggest factor. This trend follows that of other developed countries like Japan where this decline is even more pronounced.

Christian Marriage is a great treasure. Pope Benedict in a homily on the wedding reading, 1 Cor 13, said, "For only in the willingness to begin again constantly, in the ability to be magnanimous over and over and to see and recognize the original goodness, in a willingness to forgive and to put up with faults, does true great, mature love grow. Only therein does a person himself become broadminded and mature, pure and great." Marriage leads both man and woman to mature love, our ultimate goal and fulfillment. We are made in the image and likeness of God who is perfect love. To be conformed to anything else but love is a fundamental failure. To become like God, to become love, is glorious. "The Glory of God is man fully alive," wrote St. Irenaeus. Marriage invites both man and woman to commit to loving the other, to become great, to become like God.

WHY PRAY FOR THE CANONIZATION OF FATHER CAFFAREL?

There is no simpler answer than to say: "We desire that everyone discover the love God has for them, because life means being loved by God and responding to his love. We want couples to have the Joy of living better because of God's Love and for them, to Bear Witness to it in the world, and we want all Christians to discover the richness and treasure of contemplative prayer."

Mark your calendars for September 9, 2021 for the opening video of an audio-visual Novena of prayer from September 10-18, 2021 celebrating the 25th anniversary of Father Caffarel's death. The Novena will be available on the International Team's web site at Equipes-Notre-Dame.com and consist of 9 daily videos (September 10-18) accompanied by a proposal of prayer and intentions related to the theme of the day. Each video will contain an audio/video extract of Father Caffarel focusing on the theme of the day. The presentation will allow each participant to hear Father Caffarel's voice, meditate on his words, and share with others the impact that Father Caffarel has had in their life.

Finally, your donation to the Friends of Father Caffarel have helped further Father Caffarel's canonization process. Many documents have been completed and the complete collection of the Positio should be completed by the end of 2021. But more work needs to be done. The next step will be the study of the Positio by the two Commissions of the Congregation for the Cause of Saints, one consisting of Consultants and the other of Cardinals. Proposed by the latter, the acknowledgment of the heroic nature of his virtues would then be proclaimed by the Pope.



Have you ever logged into TeamsOfOurLady.org?

Are you wondering what your record has in it? Have you changed your phone number, or maybe moved? This article will attempt to help you log in.

First, using your favorite web browser visit TeamsOfOurLady.org and look in the upper right corner for a padlock with Member Login button. Clicking this button will take you to a page at TeamsLive.EWebLife.com/prm/Teams where you will see another Login button in the upper right on the page. You will see a blue button with the label "Login Instructions" which will open a PDF file with more details about logging in.

Click the button in the upper right to reach the actual login page.

Once you reach the login page enter your email address and password. If you forgot your password there is a link to reset your password on that page. Once you are actually logged in you will have the opportunity to update your profile information.

To view any information in your profile you can either click the "My Information" link at the top of the page or the "View My Profile" button a little way down the page. If you need to change any information in your profile; click the Homepage button on the top left and then the "Edit My Profile" button a bit down the page.

When you edit your information, be accurate, as the edit is taking place on the live database for Teams. Also, note that there are two sections to your profile information.

One is called "Personal Information" and the other is Additional Information". Each can be expanded with the double arrows in a circle on the left.

Assisting the Homeless

Ron and I have volunteered for many years at Immanuel Shelter, a local homeless shelter in Lewes, Delaware. Last year their lease was not renewed, so to accommodate those in need, they rented rooms from a nearby motel. This year Immanuel Shelter is out of the picture, as they are trying to buy a building for a permanent shelter. But, when one window closes, another opens.

A Sheltering Heart, a non-profit, started by Toni Short, R.N. took over. Toni already runs a transitional house for ten individuals and took on this task so that area homeless would have a warm, safe place to stay. People were sleeping in tents, cars or at friends' places. Now they have warm beds, showers, meals and are safe! Toni arranges nightly dinners for adults and children, solicits donations, helps with transportation, health needs, job searches, etc. We are so inspired with her dedication. She once was homeless after an accident. Her lifelong mission has been helping the homeless and we are blessed to help.

The COVID Pandemic has made everything more difficult for our area homeless. There is no socialization which is so important for all of us. Individuals pick up their meal and bring it back to their room. Children are schooling at the motel. The high school is providing lunches for them. Communities, churches and individuals are providing dinners and needed items such as baby products, hygiene, paper-products/plasticware, canned and packaged food, detergent, etc. I'm in charge of our local community efforts which has been making monthly dinners. I and another lady have a bin on our porch for people to put donated items in. We try to help with getting money donations. For Christmas many people bought gifts for the children. A special dinner was served and children said it was the best Christmas they ever had!

This has been a blessing in disguise! Local residence never realized we had homeless in this area since we live in a beach town. They were more than happy to help in any way. This has really brought people together during a time when we are in so much isolation!

This is the member sign in section.



Limjocos flourish in Pandemic

Uriel and Carolyn Limjoco (Western Region, Hanford Team 11) have a special tradition while driving. "We get in the car, with our prayer list, and just start praying, thinking about those people on our list, and being thankful for all the beautiful things that we encounter on our daily ride and talking about things that matter," said Carolyn. Carolyn drives while Uri brings the list and leads the prayers.

Sitting with Uri and Carolyn, there is a warm welcome, a couple at Peace, and making every day count! One would never believe that Uri was in constant pain and living on what the world would call "borrowed time", but what believers would say is God's timing. It has been three years since Uriel was diagnosed with spine cancer. He has outlived his prognosis by two years.

Married for 57 years they have written screen plays, raised six children, and worked as a US Navy Surgeon. During the past year, the Limjocos found the joy in writing together again, Uri and Carolyn have written seven books! Dusting off the Cytokine screenplay from the shelf, together the Limjocos got to work transforming this Pro-life murder mystery into a G rated book with a plot line that is suitable for all ages. They also published, "The Popes – A Brief Synopsis (from Peter to Francis)", dedicated to Fr. McGivney, founder of the Knights of Columbus, and Fr. Henry Caffarel, (Both books available on Amazon.) Their next publication will be "Kauchmin Karleq" – meaning Katherine (German) My Love (Swedish) – a love story much about the Catholic Church.

Being in Teams of Our Lady has helped to keep Uri & Carolyn close spiritually. At Sector Retreats, one commonly finds Uri playing the piano. Their Team also goes on Family "Retreat", Since the rest of the couples have young children, Uri and Carolyn provide

entertainment for the children (hiking, gaming, prayer) while their parents have time to themselves. "We've grown as a couple from all of our Teams experiences," Carolyn reflects. Their closest children and 23 grandchildren live 300 miles away, so Team 11 is their local family. "We are like grandparents to those children!"

Is it possible to have a Team's retreat and a family vacation simultaneously?

Our team found that it is! We recently booked cabins at the Holy Family Land in Bloomingdale Ohio, former Steubenville University seminary campus location. A Catholic organization called Apostolate for Family Consecration (AFC), provided everything we needed for a combined spiritual retreat and a great family vacation, during the same week!

The mornings started with personal and communal prayer, followed by Holy Mass including homilies related to personal spirituality, family life, and a formative talk (professors from Steubenville University are often invited speakers). The talk to the adults focused on faith growth, parenting and spousal relationships. Meanwhile, the children and youth go to their own classes, grouped by age and gender. In the afternoons, family could spend time at the pool, confessions, volleyball, chess tournaments, baseball games, etc.

One of the highlights for us was time around the campfire with our Team members. We shared what we learned and discussed the retreat topics while the little ones roasted marshmallows and played tag around our cabins. We felt spiritually

re-invigorated, friendship bonds with our team members increased and wonderful friendships sparked among our children during that week.

Another couple shared that their teen daughter cried because she did not want to come to the retreat, then cried afterwards because she did not want to leave.

We found that it was an easy way to keep our retreat endeavor alive while showing our children that we are not the only "crazy" ones who live out our Christian principles. All these needs could be met at the same time, have family fun, strengthen our team relationships and get closer to Jesus!
